As such, I propose that our ministry initiatives encompass four major phases that are shown in the logo on the front of this newsletter which include the initiatives to Plug In, Power Up, Press On, and Pass On. In the middle of the circle is a number four and the letter "P" joined together to represent the four P's of our ministry focus.
